Regular Monthly Water Board Meeting

May 11, 1993

The meeting was called to order by Vice-chairman Peter Grant at 7:30 p.m. Board members present were Henry Schwartz and Joe Riehl. Also present were Doug Dodd, Jim Mastne, Alan Smart of the USFS, Kathy Hubbard, Supt. Vance Hubbard, Ass't Supt Randy Stark and Dist. Clerk Carol Quinn.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as printed.

A letter from Harlan Halvorsen was read requesting a further adjustment on a leak at their property on Clara Smith Road. Mr. Riehl moved that the bill be adjusted to 25 per cent. Mr. Schwartz seconded. Passed.

Alan Smart advised the Board that the FS should have a completed version with some changes of the MOU prepared for the next meeting Wednesday, May 26, at 7:30 p.m. for discussion. He is hopeful that the EA statement will also be ready by that time. The preliminary information received from the April 16 test will have to be discussed with an analyst before conclusions are drawn. He also reported that nothing definite has been completed at the upper gate, but that engineers are working on a solution. He announced that the BPA has been very helpful regarding rehabilitation in the watershed. They will donate about 10 days equipment time for use by the bridges.

Mr. Grant advised the Board that he would plan to have a draft letter for our customers giving information update on what has been happening in the district for the last year.

Regarding the development of the South Fork, Vance reported that he is waiting to hear from Vince Brandt of Frank Lumber. He has sent him a copy of the survey and plans prepared by Compass Corp. He will be coming to the area to do some logging before long and will notify us when and we will meet with him at that time.

Randy gave a report on the Lead and Copper Rule requirements explaining that it will be difficult for the District to find the homes necessary to participate in the testing program. It will be a good idea to have homes ready to begin sampling during the first two or three months when the rule goes into effect for us on July 1, 1993.

A Budget Hearing will be held at the meeting next month at 8:00 p.m.
