Regular Monthly Board Meeting

May 14, 1985

There was no official meeting at 7:30 because a quorum of Board Members was not present. Those in attendance were Chairman H. C. Ziegler, and Pete Place, Supt. Vance Hubbard, Dist. Clerk Carol Quinn, and one visitor, Mrs. Thomes.

Mrs. Thomes came to request an adjustment of her bill due to a leak. A total of 167,000 gallons went through before the leak was discovered. The Thomes only moved into the home about 6 weeks ago so they have not established an average usage as yet. Mr. Ziegler recommended that the bill be adjusted to \$27.25 which is 1/2 of the amount due after the bill had been adjusted to 1/2 usage by the office. Mr. Place agreed and advised Carol to contact at least one other Board Member for their approval.

A letter was read from the Mult. Co. Tax supervising and Conservation Comm. advising the Board that they certified the budget without exception as presented for their review.

Mr. Ziegler was presented his election certificate.

Mr. Hubbard reported that he had not received any response from the Forest Service regarding the closure of Camp A Loop Road. Mr. Ziegler advised that Mr. Vaughan had been in touch with the Forest Ranger and that a letter would be coming.

Mr. Hubbard mentioned that the 10-year special assessment on the hook-up fee for the line extension on Loudon Rd. expired last month. Subsequent hook-up charges will be \$550.00 instead of the previous \$950.00.

Carol reported that the interest rate on our Money Market Savings is down now and suggested that a portion of the savings be transferred to a CD which would earn approximately 1 interest point more. Mr. Ziegler and Mr. Place agreed and requested that she contact another Board Member for his approval to purchase a 90-day CD that will automatically renew with the interest posted monthly to our Savings in the amount of \$30,000. This will still leave \$20,000 in savings.

Following the discussion of the above items, everyone left at 8:10 p.m.
