

CORBETT WATER DISTRICT

REGULAR MEETING AND BUDGET HEARING JUNE 8th, 1982

The meeting was held in the Water District Office and was called to order at 7:30PM by Chairman H. C. Ziegler. Present were Mr. Ziegler, Mr. Place, Mr. McNulty, Mr. Vaughan, Vance Hubbard and M. Bruun.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Hubbard brought up a request from Mr. Howard Winters for a temporary 4" irrigation line. Mr. Hubbard said 2" would be the maximum feasible and has prepared costs on such an installation.

Mr. Place moved that this request be granted, with any watering to be done with permission in advance only, at the regular domestic rates for water, after payment in full for the costs, and that an agreement to this effect be put in writing with appropriate signatures. Mr. Vaughan seconded. Passed

Mr. Place moved that Pit Run (Cliff Graff) be given a letter of permission to use the old 5" line, such letter to be modelled on the advise from Atty. Geo. Birnie, and that 5% of the revenue from the Pit Run project shall be paid to the District. Mr. Vaughan seconded. Passed

The letter to Mr. Fagan terminating his services, was reviewed and signed, after letters received from some users regarding this subject had been examined.

Mr. Place moved that office hours be from 9AM to 1 PM Monday thru Friday, effective July 1st, 1982, Mr. McNulty seconded. Passed.

The TCD maturing 6/29/82 is to be deposited in the Savings Account.

The Budget Hearing commenced at approximately 8:30

No members of the public were in attendance.

Some minor changes made at the advise of Tax Supervising were examined.

Mr. Vaughan moved that a Resolution be prepared adopting the Budget. Mr. Place seconded. Passed.
