Corbett Water District
Regular Monthly Water Board Meeting

June 14, 1988

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Don Vaughan. Board members present were Pete Place, Edith Mastne and Henry Schwartz. Also present were Glen Brisbane, Ass't Supt. Randy Stark and Dist. Clerk Carol Quinn.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as printed.

Mr. Brisbane talked with the Board about a problem he is having with rusty water periodically. He is on a dead-end line that ends at his place. It comes from Neilson Rd. to the forest service and up Woodard Rd. to his house. The District isn't sure what is causing the problem but thinks it is related to pressure changes. If this is the case, a 2 inch check valve installed on the line may solve the problem. At this time the district has no other suggestions. Mr. Place moved that a check valve be installed and hope it works. Mrs. Mastne seconded. Passed.

A thank you for the leak adjustment from Sophia MacKay was read.

Randy Stark further reported on the water use within the district. The USGS has no records of stream flow or ground water data in the area. In taking flow measurements, Mr. Stark found that it appears at this point that the South fork of Gordon Creek has more flow than the North fork even though the South fork had almost no flow last year during the summer. Further checking records has indicated that from 43 per cent to 70 per cent of our water is unaccounted for. If this could be lowered there may be no need for further conservation should a drought exist. However, there was discussion of the possibility of building a water reservoir above the water treatment plant which would allow for additional storage. The Board expressed concern about getting the altitude valves operational as soon as possible as a means of curtailing lost water.

A Public Hearing was held for the purpose of comment on the 1988-89 Budget for the Water District. There was no public comment. Mr. Place moved that the Board pass a Resolution to adopt the Budget. Mrs. Mastne seconded. Passed.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
