

MINUTES

Corbett Water District

Regular Meeting

August 9, 1983

The meeting was held in the Water District Office and was called to order by Chairman H. C. Ziegler at 7:30 p.m. Board members present were Henry Schwartz. Also present were Vance Hubbard, Superintendent, and Carol Quinn, clerk.

Since there was not a quorum present, no business was transacted.

The minutes of the last meeting will be held until next meeting.

Mr. Ziegler mentioned that he has been getting some calls from Dave Leland of the Oregon State Dept. of Health regarding the decision and direction the District plans to take regarding the Water Study Report. There was some discussion concerning sending an informational letter to our customers notifying them of the results of the study, asking their preference of the options, informing them of the availability of purchasing a filter for their water which would remove the chlorine for their household use or drinking water. Mr. Leland will be asked if an option for the District would be to purchase such a filter system for customers, with their maintaining it, in lieu of building a filtration plant. The cost of periodically replacing the filter would probably not be more than the increased rates required to build and maintain the filtration plant.

There was also some discussion of sending another letter to our customers requesting up to date information for our records re: addresses, renting or buying, how many households are using the water, etc. There should also be information included about the deposit requirement, all calls for problems to the District number and not to Vance's home number, etc.

There was some discussion about how much authority the Superintendent and Clerk have regarding equipment purchase and supply purchase.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
